What are the benefits of taking part in the Awards?

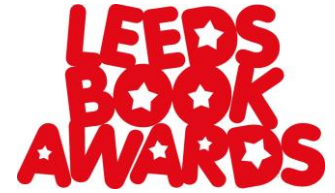
- promotes reading for pleasure through a city wide initiative

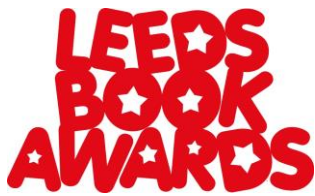
